Company Description

Kinder Morgan is one of the largest energy infrastructure companies in North America. The company owns an interest in or operates approximately 84,000 miles of pipelines and approximately 180 terminals. The company's pipelines transport natural gas, gasoline, crude oil, CO2 and other products, and its terminals store and handle petroleum products, chemicals and oilseed products, as well as bulk materials like coal and petroleum coke. In Portland, Kinder Morgan owns and operates two petroleum terminals and two pipelines, operates a bulk facility at T-4, and employs approximately 60 middle-and-higher-wage earners in the Portland area. The company's 114-mile pipeline from Portland to Eugene was the first in the nation to transport B5 biodiesel, and the 9-mile pipeline from the NW Industrial Area to PDX International Airport is used to transport all jet fuel used in commercial operations at the airport.

Transportation and Location Requirements

Pipeline, marine, rail and truck inner-connectivity, and location within the Portland energy cluster, with deep-water access, are essential elements in the supply of energy to the city, state and region. All modes of transport are used for inbound and outbound movements. The supply of fit-for-purpose fuels on a timely basis, handled in an environmentally-responsible manner, is necessary for a functioning economy and society. The terminals regularly interface with transport providers such as shipping & barging companies, piloting & tug services, railroads (long haul and regional), trucking companies, quality inspectors and regulatory authorities at all levels. The terminals interface with other pipeline & terminalling companies, and provide essential services to petroleum suppliers such as refiners, marketers, distributors and end-users.

Community Benefit

The Kinder Morgan Foundation funds programs that promote the academic and artistic interests of young people in the many cities and towns across North America where Kinder Morgan operates. The Foundation donates more than \$1 million each year to youth programs. Kinder Morgan has supported the Linnton Community Center and primary schools in the Portland/Vancouver area, and was a sponsor of the University of Portland's conference, "Confluences: Water and Justice".

Sustainable Practices/Recent Investments

In the last 10 years, Kinder Morgan has invested over \$60 million in facility improvements in Portland alone. These improvements have included capacity expansions for both cleaner-conventional and renewable fuels; seismic resiliency (primarily through construction of new and larger-replacement tanks built to recent, more stringent standards); enhanced pipeline connectivity to other terminals; safety, security, and environmental enhancements such as new dock lines, upgraded vapor recovery systems, new fire and foam systems, groundwater and storm-water containment and treatment facilities; improved Jet A filtration facilities; fuel-blending and quality assurance hardware upgrades; and many other basic infrastructure improvements. The company's primary focus is to conduct safe, environmentally-compliant and incident-free operations.
