The Columbia-Snake River (CSR) System spans 465 miles – extending from the Port of Astoria, Oregon on the Pacific Coast to the inland Port of Lewiston, Idaho – through a series of eight hydro-electric dams with navigable locks. The CSR system is first in the nation for wheat, and second in the nation for soy exports. It also leads the west coast for the export of wood and mineral bulk products.

FLEET

Tidewater and Island Tug and Barge (Tidewater Canada, Inc.) maintain a large and high-quality fleet, customized for serving customers along the Columbia-Snake River System, Vancouver, B.C., Vancouver Island, and Puget Sound ports.

- Tidewater operates **14 towboats**, which include several repowered diesel engines, and three new state-of-the-art vessels
- Island Tug and Barge operates **8 tugs**, including two new innovative, highly maneuverable articulated tug-barge units
- Fleet includes **150 barges** on the Columbia Snake River System and **7 barges** in Canada and the west coast
- Our petroleum barges are U.S. Coast Guard approved double-hulled designs equipped with radar gauging, high-level alarms, vapor recovery, and spill response equipment

MAINTENANCE

Tidewater operates its own maintenance facility, allowing us to perform nearly all our own repairs and predictive and preventive maintenance.
